**John 1:42 – And he brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, “You are Simon son of John. You will be called Cephas” (which, when translated, is Peter).**

1. Peter with his EYES on the LORD

**Matthew 14:29b-30 – Jesus said, “come.” Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, “Lord, save me.”**

2. Peter with his MIND on the STORM

**Matthew 16:15-16 – “But what about you?” Jesus asked. “Who do you say I am?” Simon Peter answered, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.”**

3. Peter with his FOOT in his MOUTH

**Matthew 16: 22-23 – Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. “Never, Lord!” he said. “This shall never happen to you.” Jesus turned and said to Peter, “Get behind me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to me; you do not have in mind the things of God, but the things of men.”**

3. Peter with his FOOT in his MOUTH

**Luke 22:60-62 – Peter replied, “Man, I don’t know what you are talking about!” Just as he was speaking, the rooster crowed. The Lord turned and looked straight at Peter.**

4. Peter with TEARS in his EYES

**Then Peter remembered the word the Lord had spoken to him: “Before the rooster crows today, you will disown me three times.” And he went outside and wept bitterly.**

4. Peter with TEARS in his EYES

**John 21:3-4 – “I’m going out to fish,” Simon Peter told them, and they said, “We’ll go with you.” So they went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing.**

5. Peter with his BOAT on the LAKE

**Acts 2:14 – Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice and addressed the crowd. “Fellow Jews and all of you who live in Jerusalem, let me explain this to you; listen carefully to what I say.”**

6. Peter with his LORD on the THRONE

**Acts 2:47b – And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.**

**1 Peter 1:1a-2 – Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ. To God's elect, strangers in the world, ... who have been chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through the sanctifying work of the spirit; for obedience to Jesus Christ and sprinkling of his blood. Grace and peace be yours in abundance.**

7. Peter with a PEN in his HAND

**I John 1:9 – “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.”**
